

## Unclaimed betting tickets

LR 91(u) states "Every Bookmaker must remain on the allocated stand and be prepared to pay out any outstanding bets until 20 minutes after the declaration of weight of the last race on the programme at the meeting on which he or she is operating".

In the event of a punter retaining an unclaimed ticket for a race meeting, a punter may receive payment by: -

1. attending a racecourse where the bookmaker is working, or
2. make and retain a photocopy of the ticket and post the original ticket to the Bookmaker at the address shown in the list of Bookmakers, or phone the Bookmaker if no address is listed.

Alternatively the ticket can be mailed to the Bookmaker, c/- NSW Bookmakers' Co-operative Ltd, 198 Pitt Street, Sydney, NSW 2000.
